

INFORMATION ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

1. The Controller of personal data of the Participants of the International AirSHOW Radom 2025 (hereinafter referred to as the Air Show) is the Military Property Agency with its registered office in Warsaw (00-911) at ul. Nowowiejska 26 A, NIP (Tax ID) 526-10-38-122, REGON (National Business Registry Number): 011263946
2. The Controller has appointed a data protection officer who can be contacted by e-mail: iod@amw.com.pl.
3. The personal data are processed for the purpose of entering into a sale contract and performing the sale of entrance tickets to the Air Show or the Controller's issue of authorisations to enter the Air Show Site on other terms, i.e., the issue of identification badges, accreditations, invitations or other types of a pass, and to fulfil obligations required by law. The personal data will be processed pursuant to:
 - 1) Article 6 (1)(c) of Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (OJ EU of 04.05.2016, L119/1), hereinafter the "GDPR", insofar as it is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Controller is subject;
 - 2) Article 6 (1)(b) of the GDPR for the purpose of entering into a sale contract and performing the sale of tickets or the issue of authorisations to enter the Air Show Site, verifying the accuracy of Air Show Participants' data on their entrance tickets, identification badges, accreditations, invitations or other types of a pass;
 - 3) Article 6 (1)(f) of the GDPR, for the establishment, exercise or defence of potential legal claims which constitute legitimate interests pursued by the Controller.
4. The personal data is freely given but necessary for the participation in the Air Show, thus the failure to provide the personal data will result in the inability to take part in the Air Show.
5. The personal data is processed during the sale of entrance tickets to the Air Show, during the issue of authorisations to enter the Air Show Site, during the Air Show, and afterwards for the period arising from rules governing the statute of limitations for civil-law claims.
6. The Participants' personal data may be provided to:
 - 1) the Polish Armed Forces' General Command, ul. Żwirki i Wigury 103, 00-912 Warsaw;
 - 2) Polskie Porty Lotnicze S.A. (Polish Airports, Joint-Stock Company) with its registered office in Warsaw, ul. Żwirki i Wigury 1, 02-143 Warsaw;
 - 3) contractors whose services the Controller may use in organising the Air Show, such as entities engaged in the sale of Air Show tickets, or contractors providing accounting, IT, advisory, legal, courier, and postal services.
7. The Air Show Participants' personal data will not be transferred to third countries or international organisations, and no automated decision-making, in particular as a result of profiling, will be carried out based on the said personal data.

8. The Air Show Participants have the right to request access to their data, to request rectification or erasure of their personal data, restriction of processing, data portability, and the right to object to the processing. To exercise the rights, they should send request to that effect to the Controller by e-mail to: iod@amw.com.pl or by post to: Agencja Mienia Wojskowego w Warszawie ul. 9. The Air Show Participants may lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if they find that their personal data are processed in breach of the GDPR.
